Broome County Medical Society

The Broome County Board is discussing an approach to United Health Services medical staff regarding an institutional membership for the physicians.

Chemung County Medical Society

An October 10, 2018 meeting was held to strengthen connections with physicians in Chemung and the surrounding areas. The turnout for the meeting brought physicians from Arnot Medical Services, Associated Radiology of the Finger Lakes, and Guthrie Healthcare to listen to õAnatomy of a Lawsuitö through MLMIC speakers.

Tompkins County Medical Society
