- **MSCA ANNUAL MEETING:**
On Tuesday, May 28th, the Medical Society of the County of Albany held its Annual Meeting at the University Club in Albany. The topic was the legalization of marijuana. Speakers included José David, M.D., Clinical Professor at the Albany Medical College and President-Elect of the Medical Society, and Luke Niforatos, Chief of Staff and Senior Policy Advisor of Smart Approaches to Marijuana (SAM).
