Councilor's Report – November 7, 2019

1. We are moving forward with the sale of the property. A law firm has been officially retained and we are moving forward with a buyer who has offered 6M to purchase the building. As of now, the only due diligence on behalf of the buyer is an environmental test around the underground oil tank area.
2. The Nassau Academy of Medicine is launching their official Educational Seminar Series on January 30, 2020 at Season's 52 and is being sponsored by MILMIC.
3. The Nassau Academy of Medicine is also working on a Community Outreach Series. The topic will be about "The Vaping Epidemic". Currently it is planned to be a Library tour of Nassau County and we hope to role it out possibly as a webinar as well.
4. The Nassau County Medical Society ED met with the EDs from LIJ and Northwell Manhasset and in a partnership with MSSNY we will be having an event promoting the Benefits of the MSSNY Membership and the County. The event is tentatively scheduled for February 26, 2020.
5. The Nassau County Medical Society and Nassau Academy is rolling by 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of 2020 a new and improved website.
6. The President's Gala has been confirmed for June 25, 2020 at Oheka Castle.
7. The ED from Nassau County Medical Society will be the organizer of the 2020 New York State Executive Director Conference.
8. There has been a new implementation of Employee Process. A new Employee Handbook, updated forms, a new evaluation process, monthly staff meetings, goal setting and performance review.
9. The ED is working on sponsors for monthly social events starting 2020. Some will be colleague social events and some will be family social events.
10. The Nassau County Medical Society is also piloting a text messaging service that would give us easier access to our members outside of email and other social media outlets.
