MSSNY Council – Alliance Report Thursday, June 18, 2015

AMSSNY just had its 79th Annual Meeting at the Saratoga Hilton April 30 - May 1 in conjunction with the MSSNY House of Delegates. We will once again have three Co-Presidents sharing the duties of the Presidency. Joan Cincotta (Onondaga County) will serve May through August, attend our AMAA meeting in Chicago, and chair our Long Range Planning meeting, as well as participate in required conference calls. Lynn Pyke (Onondaga County) will serve September through December and Co-Chair our Fall Leadership Conference in Scotia, N.Y. October 18 - 19 with Bonnie Liebers (Schenectady County). Beth Perenyi (Broome County) will serve from January through April and Co-Chair our 80th Annual AMSSNY Meeting in Tarrytown, N.Y. Each is a Past State President and will participate in conference calls monthly. This will be the second year we are using this format. An evaluation will be made in April, 2016 at our annual meeting.
