- 1) Welcome / Introductions: Dr. Haynes called the meeting to order and welcomed the committee.
- 2) Adoption of February 27, 2015 Minutes: Adopted as written.

### 3) Chairs Report:

- Report on AMA CEHCD Spring Meeting: There was discussion on clinics in drugstores and the negative impact that they may have in terms of overall outcome with regards to the minority population. It was stated that people may start to run into a local pharmacy for a "quick fix" rather than making of going in to see their primary care physician. This may contribute to the increase of health care disparity. One physician made the statement that some patients cannot afford to take time off from work and some care is better than no care. It was stated that there needs to be a way to instantly communicate with the primary physician what has/not been done.
- Update on Strategic Plans
- **CEHCD Annual Dues for Member Organizations:** When the commission was started there were several corporate sponsors. There has been a drop-off in sponsorship over the last few years and as a result the budget has dropped significantly. At the fall meeting \$250 for dues was agreed upon by the members.

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- **CEHCD Election Results:** Dr. Haynes was elected Vice-Chair for the Subcommittee on Workforce Diversity as well as a member of both the Staring Committee and Finance Committee.
  - Upcoming Doctors Back to School program, PS 127, Bronx: Both Dr. Sweeney and Dr. Hanes plan to participate in this event.

**4) Update on Diabetes Brochure:** MSSNY received a grant from Astra Zeneca which was used to create a brochure on diabetes. The brochure is available in both English and Spanish.

5) Hofstra Pipeline Programs: The program is going into its sixth year. There is one student in the BSMD program at Hofstra, one Student enrolled in Sophie Davis School of Biomedical Education and another student slated to start in the fall. The program recruits high achieving students. Physicians are recruited to come in and meet with the students. The students are recruited as rising 11<sup>th</sup> graders where they are offered the Kaplan PSA course. This year there is an Around the World Program where they will be exposed to students who are studying abroad. This year this is one student going to Yale and the other to MIT. The intent of the program is to expose the students to careers in medical care. The program takes place during the month of July. Ms. Granger invited the committee members to come see and learn more about the program. The committee agreed to do what they could to collaborate with Hofstra and help with the program.

6) **Discussion of CME Program for MSSNY House of Delegates:** The committee presented a CME program on Cultural Competency and the Impact on Health Care Outcomes which was presented by Adam Aponte, MD.
