Caring for Patients Living with and Beyond Cancer

In New York State, over one million estimated cancer survivors are living with and beyond a diagnosis of cancer. The number of cancer survivors is increasing, yet this population continues to experience gaps in care. Primary care providers have a role to play in improving the quality of life for cancer survivors. This Grand Rounds session will help primary care providers understand the long-term impact of cancer treatment on their patients and their continuing physical- and mental-health care needs by providing access to timely and evidence-based information.
