

MSSNYPAC REPORT TO THE MSSNY COUNCIL

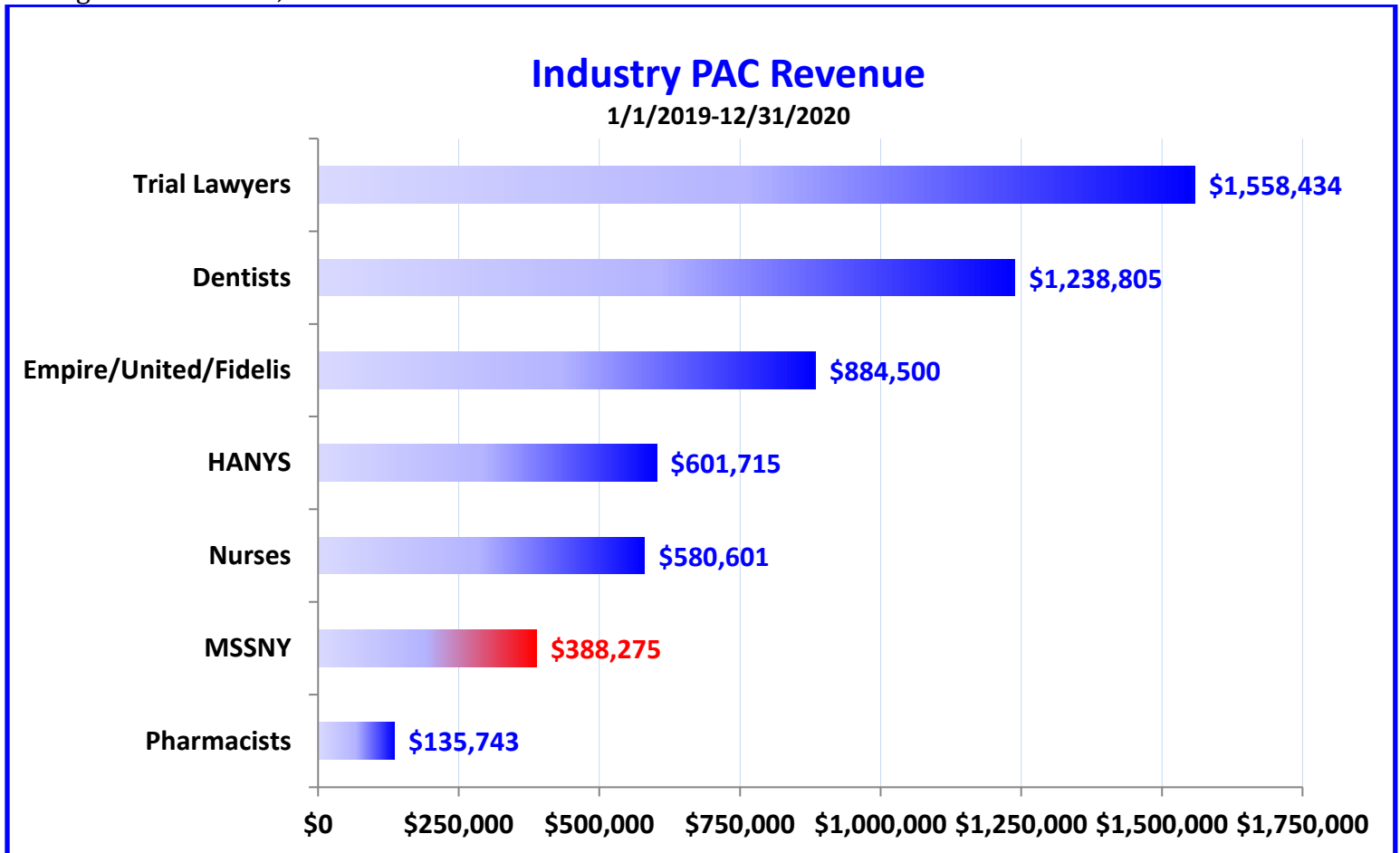

This report reflects the financial status of MSSNYPAC during the 2021 fiscal year period of 1/1/21 through 4/14/21. We have collected \$50,310.48 from 216 individual supporters. Each dollar contributed to MSSNYPAC is split between operating expenses and contributions to candidates in a ratio of 2:8. For comparison, prior year collections for the same time period are as follows:

2020: \$32,483.11 from 188 supporters
2019: \$56,299.02 from 251 supporters
2018: \$121,734.88 from 453 supporters
2017: \$67,339.12 from 343 supporters

BEST EFFORT AWARDS: (Awarded to all who qualify)

DISTINCTION: Counties have increased PAC membership (number of individual donors) by at least [10%] since prior year based on collections through Wednesday of the week prior to HOD. Outstanding Membership Improvement.

HONORABLE MENTION: Counties have achieved [10%] of Member to Potential based on collections through Wednesday of the week prior to HOD. Outstanding Membership Recruitment.

DISTINGUISHED MERIT: Outstanding Donor Achievement. Counties have contributed more than [\$10,000] to MSSNYPAC by collections through Wednesday of the week prior to HOD.

HOD MERIT: Outstanding Peer Recruitment. 100% of Delegates from each county contributed to MSSNYPAC. (Determined ongoing and announced Sunday morning of HOD). (This could be extended to other groups such as Past Presidents, Councilors, Trustees, etc.)

A certificate will be presented to all who meet the criteria.

COMPETITIVE AWARDS: (Awarded to one per tier per award category)

- 1) Highest member to potential ratio by tier
- 3) Highest PAC membership increase percentage by tier
- 3) Highest revenue by tier
- 4) Highest member gain by tier

Tiers for Competitive Awards:

- I. 1,000 or more member physicians (Nassau, NY, Queens, Suffolk, Westchester)
- II. 500-999 member physicians (Erie, Kings, Monroe, Onondaga)
- III. 100-499 member physicians (Albany, Bronx, Broome, Dutchess, Jefferson, Oneida, Orange, Otsego, Richmond, Rockland, St. Lawrence, Schenectady)
- IV. 50-99 member physicians (Chautauqua, Niagara, Rensselaer, Saratoga, Tompkins, Warren)
- V. 1-49 member physicians (Allegany, Cattaraugus, Cayuga, Chemung, Chenango, Clinton, Columbia, Cortland, Delaware, Essex, Franklin, Fulton, Genesee, Greene, Hamilton, Herkimer, Lewis, Livingston, Madison, Montgomery, Ontario, Orleans, Oswego, Putnam, Schoharie, Schuyler, Seneca, Steuben, Sullivan, Tioga, Ulster, Washington, Wayne, Wyoming, Yates)
