- The Society has a full schedule of virtual visits with local legislators for Physician Advocacy Day. Members will be meeting with 10 Manhattan legislators on the afternoon of March 8.
- The Society's Delegation to the MSSNY House of Delegates has submitted 10 resolutions to the MSSNY 2022 House of Delegates meeting.
- The Society's Social Media and Public Relations Committee is working on a social media campaign beginning in April to commemorate when the New York State legislature passed legislation authorizing medical societies in the State. The Committee chairs are Richard Schutzer, MD and Michelle Zweifler, MD.
- The Society's Single Payer Task Force, chaired by Scot B. Glasberg, MD, is continuing to review the New York Health Act with consideration as to what changes need to occur in the law to improve it for physicians. The Society will be holding educational town hall sessions with members on this topic in March.
- Society Board of Trustee chair Michael T. Goldstein, MD, JD is the first candidate to declare his intention to seek the GOP nomination to challenge U.S. Rep. Jim Himes, a Democrat from Greenwich who has

represented the 4th District since defeating Republican Christopher Shays in 2008.
