Councilor's Report – June 23, 2022 Stavroula Savelidis, MS, PhD Candidate - Councilor

- 1. On June 6, 2022, the Federation lost one of its founding members. Kathleen Dyman, Executive Director of Medical Societies of the Counties of Oneida, Herkimer, Madison, Chenango, Oswego, and Cayuga passed away. The Federation extended its thoughts and prayers to the family, friends and county leadership for their immense loss.
- 2. The Federation met at the House of Delegates, on May 20, 2022. It was the first In-Person Executive Director Meeting in over two years. We had presentations from MSSNY Leadership and MLMIC and collaborated on the best ways to partner and support each other in better supporting our memberships.
- 3. The Federation on May 20, 2022, voted on their new Councilor for the term 2022-2025. The new Councilor unanimously voted in was Nassau County Medical Society Executive Director, Stavroula Savelidis, MS, PhD Candidate.
- 4. The Federation is planning a meeting with the MSSNY Membership Leadership and the Membership Committee to discuss ways to attract new members and to also work on retention initiatives for our current members. We will also be discussing group memberships and strategic planning on dues collection.
- 5. MSSNY and the Federation is collaborating on the software system, Impexium and what would be the most comprehensive utilization for the counties and MSSNY.
