• STRIDES FOR SURVIVORS:

April was Sexual Assault Awareness Month and Child Abuse Prevention Month, and National Crime Victims' Rights Week was recognized Sunday, April 24 through April 30. In recognition, St. Peter's Crime Victim Services spent the month of April providing education programs, events, and fundraisers, including the 2nd Annual Strides for Survivors 5k Run/Walk/Roll. Strides for Survivors' goal is to engage our community in important conversations around victimization, community response, and prevention. This year, participants and sponsors raised nearly \$10,000 to support St. Peter's Crime Victim Services' mission of reducing the impact of crime.

• ALBANY MEDICAL COLLEGE ANNOUNCES NEW DEAN, HOSPITAL DIRECTOR: Alan Boulos, MD, a longtime Albany Med neurosurgeon and 1994 graduate of Albany Medical College, has been named the 18th dean of Albany Medical College. He is the third alumnus to be named to the medical school's top position. Dr. Boulos, of Glenmont, was approved as the college's new dean by the Albany Med Health System Board of Directors on May 4. He succeeds Vincent P. Verdile, MD, '84, the second-longest tenured dean of an American medical college, who received the honorary title of dean emeritus at the end of 2021. Dr. Boulos began serving as interim dean in January 2022.

Peter G. Paige, MD, has been named executive vice president and hospital general director of Albany Medical Center. Trained as an emergency medicine physician, Dr. Paige most recently served as executive vice president, chief physician executive and chief clinical officer for Jackson Health System in Miami, where he oversaw the chief medical officers of each hospital within the system. He had also served as chief medical officer for Miami-Dade County, responsible for helping to lead its Covid-19 response and recovery since November 2020.
