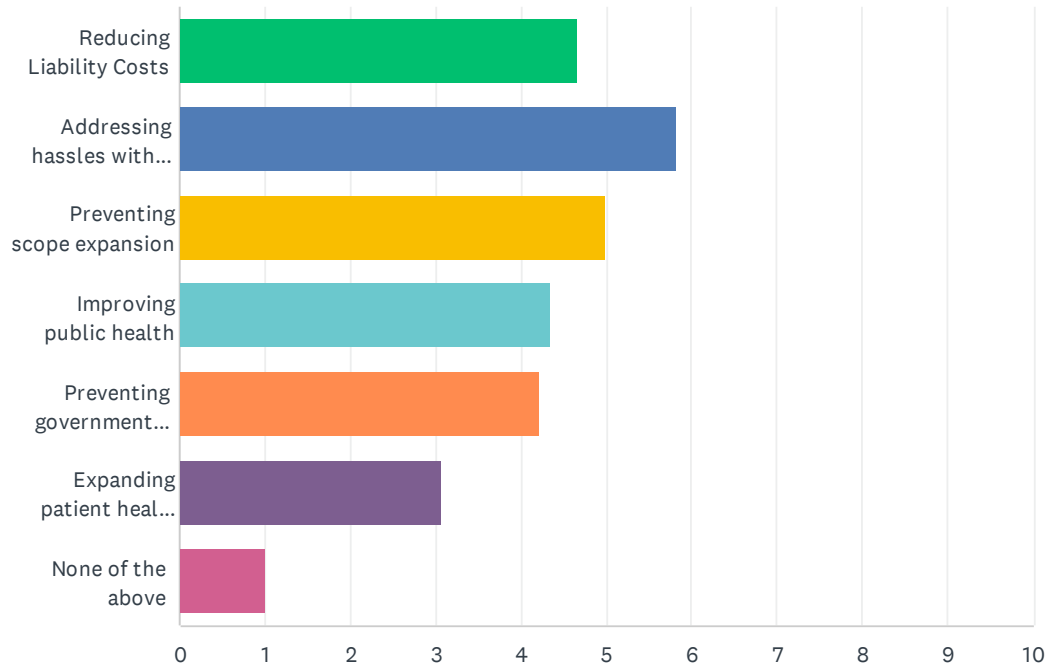


Q1 Which issue area matters most to you? Please rank, 1 being most important and 7 being least.

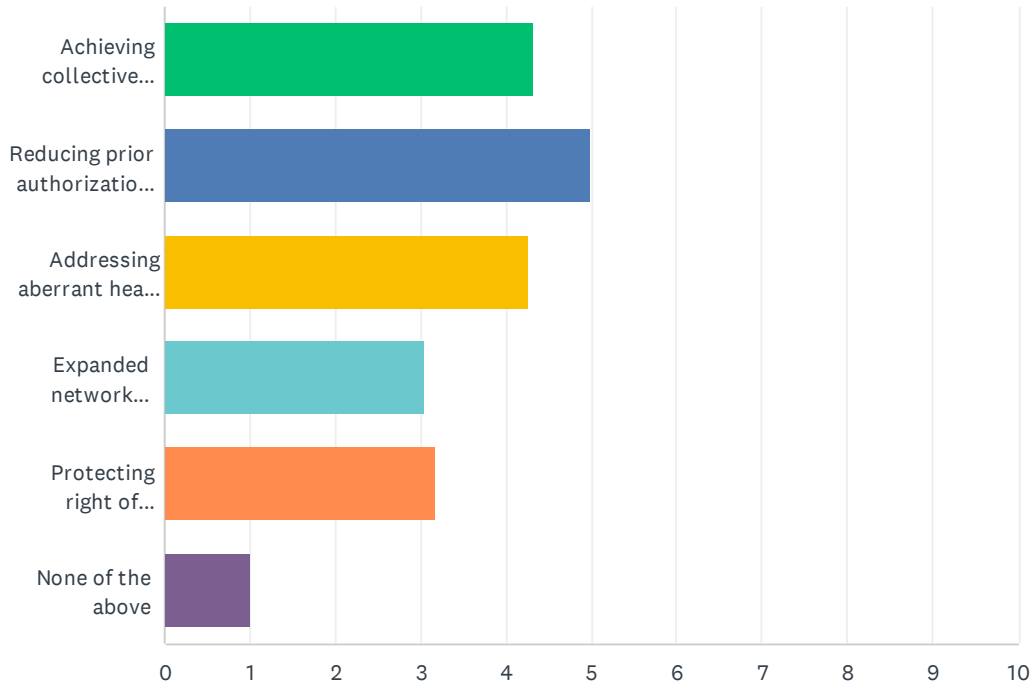

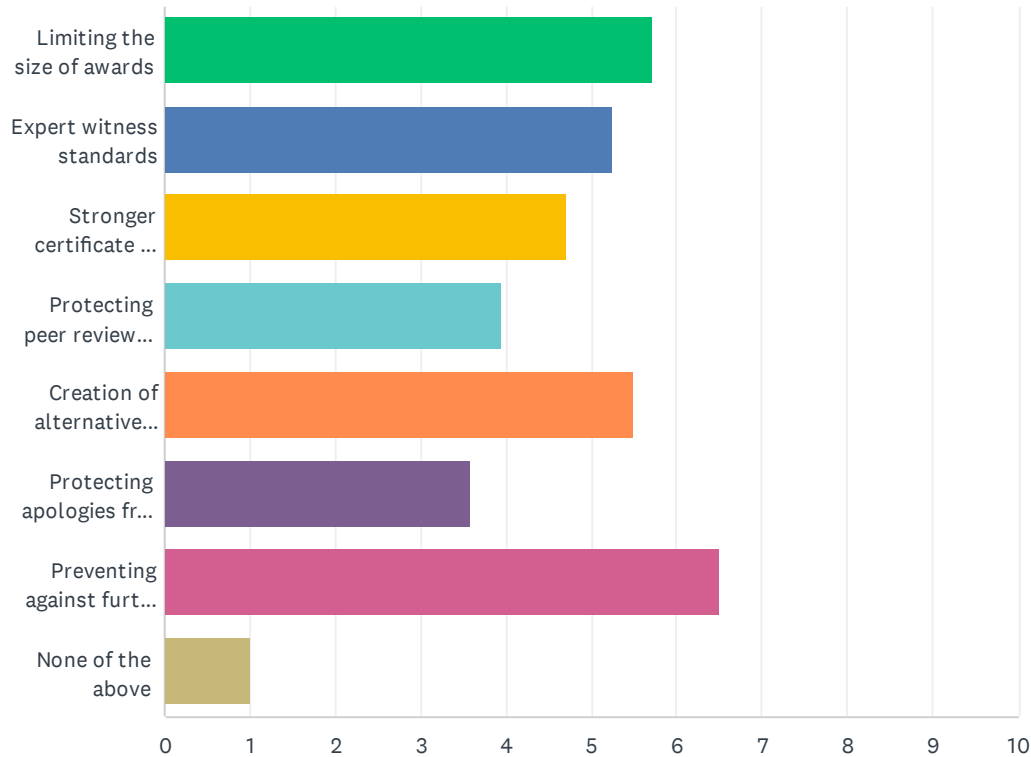

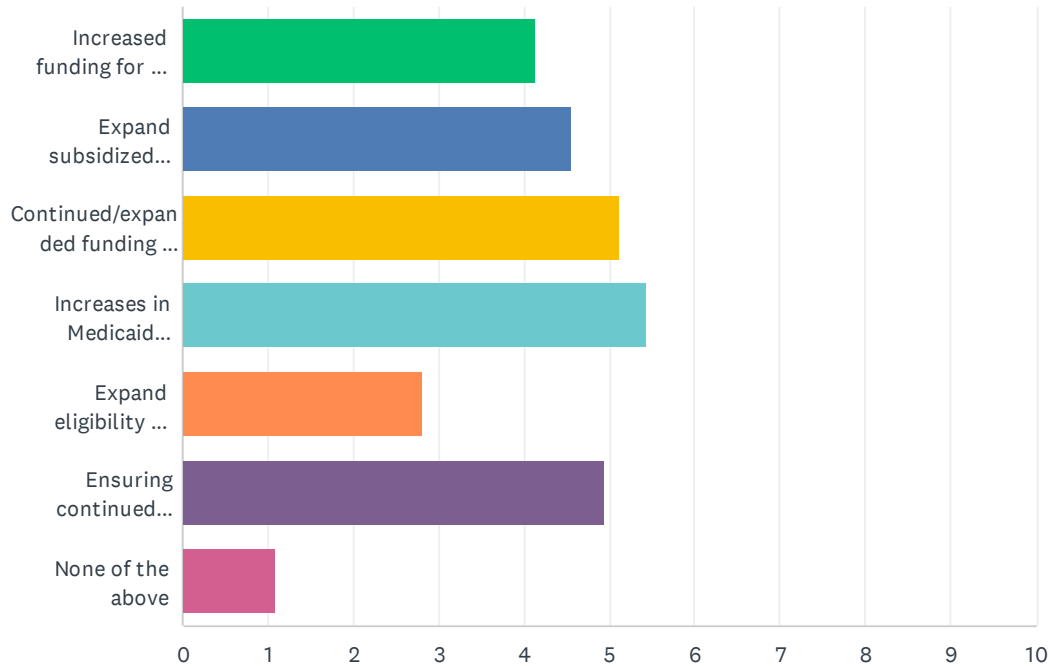

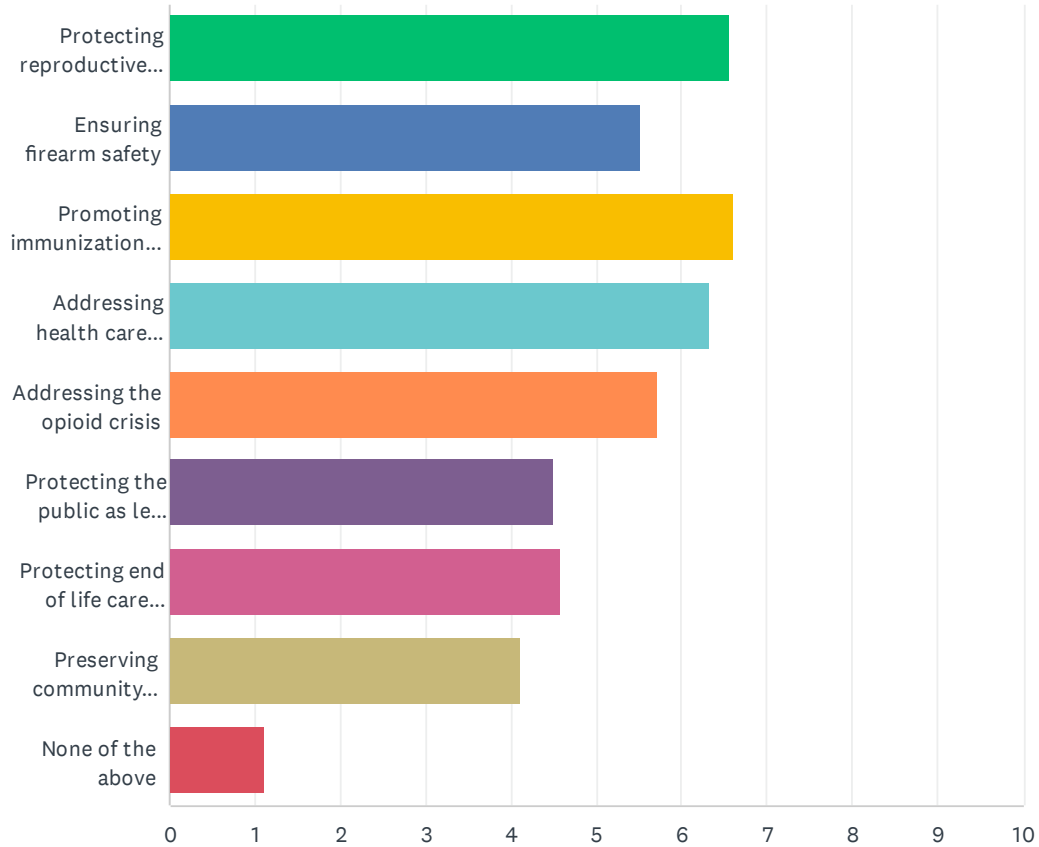
